Louisa County Building – Look for VMGA Signs

The main road serving the Louisa area is Route 22

NOVA (Northern VA, from Arlington, Ballston Metro Stop)

- South via I-95/Fredericksburg/US-208 (90 miles, 2 hours)
- West/South via I-66/US-29/Culpeper (100 miles, 2 hours)

Richmond – West 60 miles (1 hour);

Charlottesville – East 35 miles (45 minutes);

Culpeper – South 40 miles (50 minutes);

I-64 – North 12 miles (20 minutes), VA-208, Exit 143.

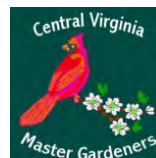
From Northern VA (NOVA): take I-95 South or I-66 West/US-29 South, see approx travel times above.

From Richmond: take I-64 West to the VA-208 EXIT 143- toward LOUISA/FERNCLIFF. Turn right onto Courthouse Road (VA-208) and drive approximately 8 miles into the Town of Louisa until you come to the traffic light; turn left at the light on Main Street and proceed to the next traffic light. Turn left onto Rosewood Ave. then left at the stop sign onto Woolfolk Avenue. You will be facing the front of the Louisa County Office Building.

From Charlottesville: take I-64 East to the VA-208 EXIT 143- toward LOUISA/FERNCLIFF. Turn left onto Courthouse Road (VA-208) and drive approximately 8 miles into the Town of Louisa until you come to the traffic light. Turn left at the light on Main Street and proceed to the next traffic light. Turn left onto Rosewood Ave. then left at the stop sign onto Woolfolk Avenue. You will be facing the front of the Louisa County Office Building.

From Culpeper: take US-522 South (Zachary Taylor Hwy) to the town of Mineral; turn right onto Route 208/22 West (Jefferson Davis Hwy) and drive approximately 5 miles into Town of Louisa. At the third traffic light, Turn left onto Rosewood Ave. then left at the stop sign onto Woolfolk Avenue. You will be facing the front of the Louisa County Office Building.
